- The winner will be announced at the Wellington HITO Graduation event on 10 November 2024.

- What motivates you to perform to your best ability and achieve the best results in your work?
- What other activities outside of your workplace have you been involved in to grow your skills?
- How do you use social media to boost your profile?
- Give two (2) examples of how you contribute to a positive work environment.
- Name two (2) goals you have for the future and how you plan to achieve them.
- How would you support HITO and other apprentices if you won Apprentice of the Year?
- Why should we select you as Central Apprentice of the Year?

Please note:

Written entries must not exceed 1500 words and videos must not exceed 5 minutes.

References

At least two (2) written references are required. Please ensure references are from your employer senior stylists, clients and/ or someone who knows you well.

References should reflect the qualities we're looking for in the Apprentices of the Year, verifying the statements by the apprentice.

The best entrants will:

- Have a strong work ethic this award is not just about being the most technically skilled hairdresser, barber, or beauty therapist.
- Show commitment to training, set their own goals, and give examples of how they'd like to contribute to the industry.
- Be a great role model to prospective and current apprentices, people in their community, and the industry.
- Complete training plans and unit standards in the required timeframe, as set by their Sales and Training Advisor.
- Have the confidence to support, represent and champion HITO and apprenticeship training.
- Be an advocate for apprenticeships and explain the importance of being an apprentice.
- Consider the presentation of their submission.

Judging process

At all stages, judges score independently of other judges. Stage one of judging is carried out by HITO representatives. HITO will verify your progress and achievements upon receipt of entry. Tip: Make sure you answer all the questions outlined in the above criteria. Stage two of judging is carried out by hair, beauty, and barbering industry representatives. During this stage, a shortlist of finalists are identified.
